FLOWER ART MUSEUM

The art of botanical drawing has a long tradition, dating back to the first half of the sixteenth century. At the time, botanical images were often used in herbal books for medicinal purposes. To acknowledge this special art form, the Flower Art Museum in Aalsmeer will host a special exhibition, Flora Botanica, until September 29th. DUTCH RESISTANCE MUSEUM

The Dutch Resistance Museum, known to locals as the Verzetmuseum, details the history of the Dutch resistance in World War II during the country's occupation by Germany. The permanent exhibition takes visitors back to the 1930s and 1940s with its life-like street scenes and recreated interiors of Dutch homes. SARPHATIPARK

Named after the Jewish doctor and founder of the Amstel Hotel, Samuel Sarphati (1813-1866), whose marvellous 19th century monument dominates the park, is a green oasis in the heart of the city. With features such as a pond, fountain and enclosed playground, it is the perfect place to enjoy the last rays of sun.
